**Computer**: A bank accepts fixed deposits for one year or more and the policy it adopts on interest is as follows:-

- 1. If a deposit is less than Rs.2000 and for 2 or more years the interest rate is 5 % compound annually.
- 2. If a deposit is Rs. 2000 or more but less than 6000 and for 2 or more years the interest rate is 7 percent compounded annually.
- 3. If a deposit is more than Rs.6000 and is for 1 years or more, the interest is 8% compounded annually.
- 4. On all deposits for 5 years or more, interest is 10 percent compounded annually.
- 5. On all other deposits not covered by above conditions, the interest is 3% compounded annually.
