After the joyous success of the past two story books published by and for Asianites, we now announce the next one, which will be released on our 25th Founders Day.

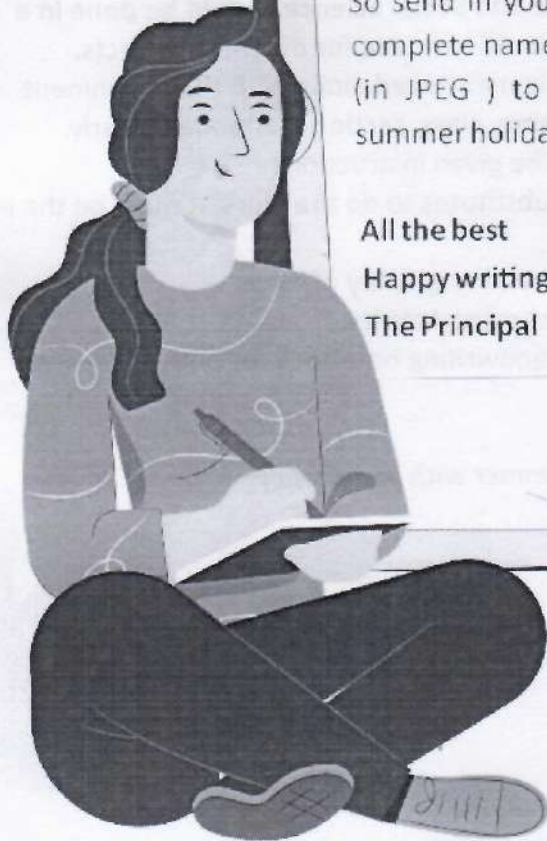
