

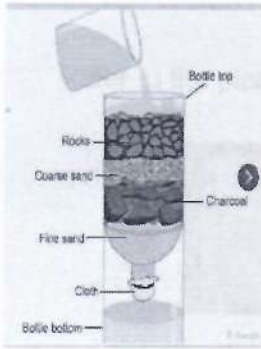

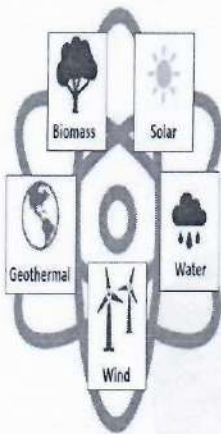
## SCIENCE
